



ANNUAL REPORT 2020





July 1, 2019, saw the start of our new fiscal year with significant opportunities of record-breaking impact, for growth, and the start of a strategic planning effort that would launch CTN's long-term future.

Partnerships with other organizations were growing. We moved hundreds of international guests during conferences for Purdue Fort Wayne and the Fort Wayne Children's Zoo. Thousands of our youngest citizens experienced field trips through their early learning centers.

We've supported the daily rides to work and workshops for more than 80 individuals with disabilities. And regularly provided a ride every other day to more than 60 low-income individuals going to dialysis. As January 2020 rolled in, we were on track to provide 110,000 trips to 9,000 individuals.

In March, the world stopped. CTN was not immune to Covid-19's catastrophe. Within a week, 85% of CTN's service stopped. Staff shifted operations to support priority riders. Focusing on those who needed access to life-sustaining services like dialysis and chemotherapy.

In early April we started asking, "How can we help?" Doctors' offices were not open, so we filled our time supporting other community needs.

We provided on-demand transportation to our region's Covid-positive homeless shelter. We distributed 1500+ PPE packets to seniors on behalf of Aging and In-Home Services. And special donations enabled us to provide free rides to food banks and the grocery store.

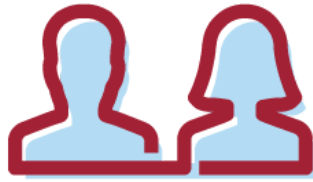
Our team adapted to the changing environments quickly, never losing sight of our mission. We are so deeply proud of the resiliency and care the team has had this year. They've adjusted to every curve ball thrown. Extra cleaning, wearing masks, schedule changes, they did it all! And we're not done yet!

In the end, we provided 72,419 trips to 6,479 individuals. Clearly, short of our goals. But in the midst of the global pandemic, our impact was even greater than the numbers suggest.

CTN worked hard to keep people healthy and in their own homes. We've been able to do that because of the amazing philanthropic support of our donors and friends. To them, we say thank you.

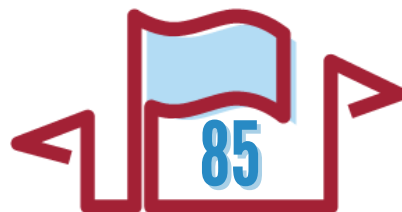
