





Driving Independence


Independence looks different for everyone. For Jo'Male, independence is being able to go to work and saving up for your own vehicle, where you get even greater independence. For Helen, independence is being able to live on your own and scheduling your own rides to the doctor. At CTN we cherish the independence we're able to provide and measure it by how long riders have been with us.

- Nearly 20% of our medical riders have been using CTN for more than five years!
- In total, CTN provided 71,736 total rides to 8,629 riders.
- Our vehicles covered more than 500,000 miles.
- And for the first time ever, we operated out of two locations.

It was July 1st, 2022, when we opened the Memmer Family Garage, a satellite garage located on the west side of New Haven. Six routes originate from the facility and are designed to pick up their first riders in New Haven, east Allen County, or southeast Fort Wayne. With 15,000 square feet of finished space, and the ability to expand to nearly 55,000 square feet, this facility represents our future.

Another step in our future is the first-of-its-kind Regional Transportation Assessment launched in spring 2023. This assessment mirrors the community needs assessment completed by Foellinger Foundation in the late 1990's that resulted in the creation of CTN. As CTN's board of directors looked to our future, we started with asking about the state of transportation in the 11-county region of northeast Indiana. Results of the assessment will be available in early 2024 and will serve as a guidepost for CTN's future, as well as the future of other transportation providers in northeast Indiana.

One common theme through the assessment, so far, has been the need for independence. Our communities are designed around vehicle ownership. Having a vehicle, or a transportation option, means independence. Something we don't realize until we don't have it any longer.



Meet Jo'Male. He has been riding with CTN for the past few years to go to work. And because of that seemingly simple thing, a ride, he was able to purchase his own vehicle, providing him with independence and empowering him to hope for the future.

When Jo'Male moved to Fort Wayne, he and his aunt searched for ride services to help him access medical care and his college courses. He was referred to CTN and was relieved to discover we accepted his insurance through Medicaid. After college, when he lost his insurance, he was still able to rely on CTN to get him to and from work through our work trips program.

"I knew if I called CTN, my trips would be consistent, and with my first job, I wanted to make a good impression," he said.

Jo'Male credits the rides he received from CTN as his biggest step towards independence. Without a job, he couldn't afford to pay rent or save towards his goal of purchasing his own vehicle.

"With CTN, I am able to keep living independently," he reflected. "Because of them, I was able to purchase my own vehicle, so now I can plan to meet up with friends and get where I need to go. My future looks less isolated. I feel like an actual adult who doesn't have to ask permission to leave my house."

As 2023 comes to a close, we reflect on the profound impact that accessible transportation can have on our clients. Jo'Male said it better than we ever could: "Thank you all! Through your donations, you have literally changed my life. I now work full-time, and I am in line for a promotion!"




